


# Instructions to access the NCHPAD's Disability Education for Educators

2. Click on the Educators tab.

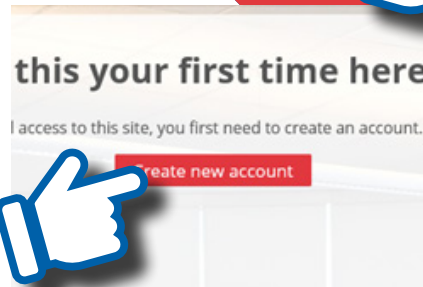
3. Click on the Disability Education for Educators Course.
